Eligible Projects

 Projects deploying qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved (25/3 Mbps or less) and underserved (between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps) locations

Eligible Areas

Elible areas will be determined by the broadband office challenge process

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and multi tenant buildings
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible multi-family residential building
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including Registered Apprenticeships and pre-apprenticeships, and community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Scoring (maximum of 100 points): Primary criteria

- **Efficient Use of BEAD Funding (up to 40 points):** How much funding (exclusive of mandatory 25% minimum match) is requested.
- Affordability and Plans (up to 30 points):
 - 10 points for offering symmetrical 1 Gbps service for less than \$100/month with no fees
 - 10 points for Low-Cost option and Middle-Class Affordability Plans
 - 10 points for Wholesale Service Offering

Selection Criteria (cont'd)

- Fair Labor Practices (up to 15 points):
 - 7.5 points for Regional Local Hire Program
 - 7.5 points for Alaska Experience & Alaska-based Workforce

Secondary criteria (up to 15 points):

- 5 points for Speed to Deployment
- 5 points given for Nontraditional Provider
- 5 points given for Use of SOA/DNR/OPMP Resources

Application Process
