Eligible Projects

 Qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure projects to unserved (25/3 Mbps or less) and underserved (between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps) broadband serviceable locations

Eligible Areas

Applicants will select project areas from the Project Area Map

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecom equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and MDUs
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible MDU
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including registered apprenticeships, pre-apprenticeships, community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Determination of Priority Broadband Project vs Non-Priority Broadband Project

- Primary Scoring Minimal BEAD Program Outlay. The Eligible Entity must select the combination of project proposals with the lowest overall cost to the Program
- **Secondary Scoring**: Applicants within 15% of the lowest grant request for the same application area, scoring will be applied in these areas:
 - Speed to Deployment
 - Speed of Network
 - Latency, and other technical capabilities
