



BEAD Map Challenge Process

Key Dates

March 25 - April 23, 2024 - Challenge Submission Window (30 Days)

March 25 - May 23, 2024 — Rebuttal Submission Window (30 Days from notification to respond)

June 22, 2024 - Determination Phase Ends (30 Days)

Eligible Challengers

- Nonprofit organizations
- Units of Local and Tribal Government
- Internet Service Providers

Allowable Challenges

- Identification of eligible community anchor institutions
- Community anchor institution BEAD eligibility determinations
- BEAD eligibility determinations for existing broadband serviceable locations
- Enforceable commitments
- Planned service (deployed by June 30, 2024)
- Speed tests will be collected from individuals to be submitted by an eligible challenger in order to determine eligibility.

Submission Process

- Request a free CostQuest License
- The two license tiers available for BEAD Challenge Process are:
 - Tier D: For entities that participate in any federal broadband programs. Licensees will be similar to those with an FCC Fabric Tier 2 license. Please follow the guide for requesting a TIER D License
 - Tier E: For entities that will challenge "Pass Through Entity" coverage maps (i.e. the CBO). Licensees will be similar to those with an FCC Fabric Tier 4 license.
 Please follow the guide for requesting a TIER E License
- Pre-registration on the State challenge portal
 - Suggested for anyone planning to submit a challenge or rebuttal to a challenge
- Select location and challenge type
- Upload Evidence
 - Speed Test
 - Documentation of Planned Service
- Submit Challenge
