# **Eligible Applicants**

- Cooperatives
- Nonprofit Organizations
- Public-Private Partnerships
- Private Companies
- Public or Private Utilities
- Public Utility Districts
- Local Governments
- Round 2 is open to all Applicants, even if Applicant did not submit Round 1 application

# **Eligible Projects**

- Qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure projects to unserved (25/3 Mbps or less) and underserved (between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps) broadband serviceable locations
- CBO may turn to Alternative Technology providers to negotiate service for remaining BSLs

## **Eligible Areas**

- Applicants will select project areas from the Project Area Map
- Project area do not need to be contiguous

# **Eligible Costs**

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecom equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and MDUs
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible MDU
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including registered apprenticeships, pre-apprenticeships, community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

#### **Selection Criteria**

# Scoring (maximum of 498 points) Primary criteria

- Minimal BEAD Outlay (up to 200 points)
  - o **100 points** for total match
  - 100 points for Project Cost efficiency
- Affordability (up to 200 points): Cost of symmetrical 1 Gbps service
  - 10 points for Urban Rate Survey (URS) or below
  - 25 points for 20% or more below URS
  - o **75 points** for 30% or more below URS
  - 100 points for 40% or more below URS
  - 150 points for 50 % or more below URS
  - o **175 points** for 60% or more below URS
  - 200 points for 70% or more below URS
- Fair Labor Practices (up to 98 points): details past compliance with federal fair labor laws, and commit to following federal fair labor practices:
  - 20 points for certification of compliance
  - 20 points for compliance with federal employment laws
  - 15 points for disclosure of applicant violations
  - 15 points for disclosure of sub/contractor violations
  - 15 points for wage information
  - 13 points for workplace safety committees

# Selection Criteria, (Con't.)

#### Secondary criteria

- Speed to Deployment (up to 28 points)Points will be calculated as follows:
  - 29 points for build completion in <25 months</li>
  - o **18 points** for completing the build within 25-35 months
  - o **10 points** for completing the build within 36-41 months
  - o **6 points** for completing build within 42-47 months
  - o points for completing build > 48 months
- Speed of Network and other Technical Capabilities (Up to 25 points)
  - 25 points for XGS-PON 10 Gbps upload & 10 Gbps download or greater
  - o **20 points** for XG-PON 2.5 Gbps upload & 10 Gbps download or greater
  - 15 points for G-PON 1 Gbps upload & 2.5 Gbps download
  - 10 points for E-PON 1 Gbps upload & download
- Open Access (up to 14 points)
  - 5 points for details regarding Open Access policy
  - 5 points for a description of wholesale services & rates
  - 4 points for Identification of retail ISP partners and status of MOU
- Local & Tribal Coordination (up to 10 points)
  - 5 points for Local and Tribal Coordination & Consultation meeting
  - 5 points for Local and Tribal Letter of Support
- Equitable Workforce Development & Job Quality (up to 49 points)
- Community Impact (up to 40 points)
  - o **8 points** to increase Broadband Adoption & Digital Literacy
  - 8 points for Major Economic Development
  - o **8 points** for Broadband Planning Initiative
  - 8 points for Strategic Partnerships
  - 8 points for State Plan
