Key Dates

- August 22,2023 Application Period Opens
- December 1, 2023 Application Period Closes at 4:00 p.m. CT
- **December 31, 2026** Project Construction Completed
- **December 31, 2027** Project Construction Completed (Black Hills area applications only)

Eligible Applicants

All providers across the state

Eligible Areas

- Areas that lack access to at least 100/200 Mbps
- Primary areas of focus include locations in the Black Hills Region
- Areas that have been awarded public funds, but have not yet constructed, may be considered underserved

Eligible Projects

- Applicants may submit multiple projects with multiple phases
 - Each must be capable of standing on its own
- Projects must meet a minimum of 250/20 Mbps upon completion

Scoring Criteria

- Service Speeds Available Upon Project Completion up to 20 points
- Financial Support and Provider Match up to 25 points
- Community Interest Level up to10 points
- Community Anchor Institution up to 5 points
- Tribal Nation Lands up to 5 points
- Project Timelines up to 15 points
