- Other entities that develop and/or operate broadband networks and can demonstrate they satisfy grant obligations

Eligible Areas

 Any location including one or more residence, business, or community anchor institution in an Unserved (no access to broadband service of at least 25/3 Mbps) or Underserved (access to broadband service above 25/3 but below 100/20 Mbps) area

Eligible Projects

- Must meet general CPF Program requirements
- Contain a Last Mile component
- May include a Middle Mile component only when necessary to facilitate Last Mile connection

Eligible Costs

Categories of eligible project costs include:

- Make ready
- Design and engineering
- Permitting and regulatory compliance
- Network equipment, fiber/cabling, facilities and materials
- Construction and installation
- Qualifying Long Drop, Non-Standard Customer Installation costs
- Qualifying Overbuild costs
- Leases for terms longer than one year of facilities required to provide broadband service
- Personnel costs
- Costs associated with monitoring and reporting requirements in compliance with MBI and United States Department of the Treasury reporting requirements

Selection Criteria

Scoring (maximum of 106 points):

- Support of Target Populations and Equity up to 30 points
- Applicant's Ability to Execute the Project up to 25 points
- Project Feasibility and Reasonableness up to 25 points
- Technological Approach up to 20 points
- Optional Bonus Criteria up to 6 points
