Up to \$148 million from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund (CPF)

Eligible Applicants

- Communications service provider including but not limited to private sector carriers, local governments, utilities, and other entities
- Must own the network constructed with grant funds and facilitate last-mile connections to eligible service locations
- Active federal System for Award Management <u>(SAM) registration</u> prior to close of application window

Eligible Areas

- Projects in the newly established Broadband Intervention Zones
- Areas without service at speeds greater than or equal to 100/20 Mbps

Eligible Projects

- Provide a minimum of 100/100 Mbps
- Provide 100/20 Mbps due to cost of the project, geography, or topography of the area, must be scalable to 100/100Mbpswithin three years of project completion

Eligible Costs

- The installation of Broadband Infrastructure that facilitates covered speeds to eligible locations
- Expenditures for the buildout or acquisition of middle-mile service that facilitates covered speeds to eligible locations
- Expenditures that comply with the U.S. Department of the Treasury found <u>here</u>
- Permitting, planning, architectural design, engineering design, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs relating to salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants

• Costs incurred prior to September 30, 2026

Ineligible Costs

- Land, buildings, structures, improvements, or equipment not directly used in the transmission of data via Broadband
- Removing existing Broadband Infrastructure, fixtures, or other real property
- Indirect labor costs or administrative overhead
- Passthrough expenditures with respect to subcontractors or other third parties that are not at arm's length transactions or reflective of fair market rates
- Identified as ineligible expenditures pursuant to any CPF requirements
- Inconsistent with or not permitted by the U.S. Department of the Treasury guidance found here
- Acquisition of spectrum licenses
- Operating expenses
- Short-term operating leases
- Payment of interest or principal on outstanding debt instruments or other debt service costs incurred prior to March 15, 2021
- Fees or issuance costs associated with the new debt
- Satisfaction of any obligation arising under or pursuant to a settlement agreement, judgment, consent decree, or judicially confirmed debt restructuring plan in a judicial, administrative, or regulatory proceeding

- Broadband Intervention Zone Ranking up to 22.22%
