Eliaible Areas

- KOBD will determine project areas
- Subgrantees may propose alternate project areas by combining contiguous project funding areas
- Kansas PFA's kmz Map file
- Kansas PFA's GIS Map file

Eligible Projects

- Projects that expand high-speed internet access and use, including:
 Infrastructure deployment, mapping, adoption, planning, capacity-building in state offices, local community outreach and coordination
- **Priority Broadband Projects are:** Applications that propose to construct end-to-end fiber-optic facilities to all unserved and underserved BSLs in a Project Funding Area

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecom equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and MDU's
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible MDU
- Network Software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, environmental, historical and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including registered apprenticeships, pre-apprenticeships, community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Scoring (maximum 100 points)

Primary criteria:

- Minimal BEAD Program Outlay up to 50 points
 - Lowest cost to serve will receive maximum points and highest cost to serve will receive 0 points. Applications between highest and lowest cost points assigned proportionately
- Affordability up to 15 points
 - Scoring based on cost of 1Gbps/1Gbps service
 - less than \$90 15 points
 - \$90.01 \$99.99 10 points
 - \$100 \$109.99 6 points
 - \$110 \$119.99 3 points
 - \$120 or higher 0 points
- Fair Labor Practices up to 10 points
- Speed to Deployment up to 9 points
- Speed of Network up to 9 points
- Local and Tribal Coordination up to 7 points

Secondary criteria:

- Minimal BEAD Program Outlay up to 50 points
 - Lowest cost to serve will receive maximum points and highest cost to serve will receive 0 points. Applications between highest and lowes cost points assigned proportionately
- Affordability up to 15 points
 - Scoring based on cost of 100/20 Mbps service
 - less than \$60 15 points
 - \$60.01 \$69.99 10 points
 - \$70 \$79.99 6 points
 - \$80 \$89.99 3 points
 - \$90 or higher 0 points
- Fair Labor Practices up to 10 points
- Speed to Deployment up to 9 points
- Speed of Network to 9 points
- Local and Tribal Coordination up to 7 points
