 - Applicants required to have pre-qualification approval to apply for BEAD

Eligible Projects

 Projects deploying qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved (25/3 Mbps or less) and underserved (between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps) locations

Eligible Areas

 Determined by the broadband office challenge process and posted to the <u>ConnectLA BEAD</u> <u>program</u> website

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and multi tenant buildings
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible multi-family residential building
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including Registered Apprenticeships and pre-apprenticeships, and community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Scoring:

Primary criteria

- Minimal BEAD Outlay up to 300 points
 - % of funding level requested for a total project area
- Affordability up to 200 points
 - Previous or future commitments to offer 1 Gbps/1 Gbps service to at least 1,000 customers for at least five consecutive years

Selection Criteria (cont'd)

- Fair Labor Practices up to 101 points
 - Certifying full compliance and no violations within the last 3 to 5 years
 - Use of a directly employed workforce
 - Use of local hire provisions
 - Pay prevailing wages, benefits, and compliance with Davis-Bacon

Secondary Criteria

- Speed to Deployment up to 12 points
 - o Points for enforceable deployment plans faster than 48 months
- Economically Disadvantaged Areas up to 25 points
 - Points for inclusion

Application Process

Applicants must have been approved during the Pre-qualification Phase
