Key Dates

January 27 – Issuance of NOFO, Scoring Guide, and Application
January 27 - March 21 – Application Submission Window
March 24 – April 4 – OBAE reviews and scores applications
April 7 – April 16 – Applicants may be requested to provide supplemental information
Early to mid-May – Provisional awardees will be contacted
End of May - Awardee signs Grant Award Agreement
End of June - Awardee to start grant-funded activities and incur expenses
December 31, 2026 - Project must be completed and all grant and match funds be expended

Eligible Areas

- Geographic areas covered by Executive Order in areas declared a disaster 2022-2024
- Eligible unserved and underserved BSLs in declared disaster areas

Eligible Projects

• Last-mile networks that provide connectivity to unserved and underserved households and businesses in declared disaster areas (e.g., those impacted by the wildfires and floods)

Eligible Costs

- Permitting and regulatory reviews (e.g., rights of way, easement, environmental, historical and cultural assessment); network planning & design; infrastructure deployment; network equipment; grants administration and reporting
- Expenses incurred after issuance of a Purchase Order by OBAE

Selection Criteria

Scoring (maximum of 100 points):

- Speed to Deployment up to 36 points 36 points for ≤ 6 months 30 points for 7 to 8 months 24 points for 9 to 10 months 18 points for 11 to 12 months 12 points for 13 to 14 months 6 points for 13 to 14 months 6 points for 15 to 16 months 0 points for 17 to 18 months
 Community Support - up to 16 points
 Matching Contribution Degree - up to 16 points
 - **16 points** for 45% or greater **14 points** for 42.5% – 44.9% **12 points** for 40% – 42.49% **10 points** for 37.5% – 39.9% **8 points** for 35% - 37.49% **6 points** for 32.50% – 34.9% **4 points** for 30% – 32.49% **2 points** for 27.5% – 29.9% **0 points** Below 27.5%
- Cost Efficiency up to 16 points
- Comprehensive Community Impact up to 16 points
