Eligible Projects

 Projects deploying qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved 25/3 Mbps or less and underserved between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps locations

Eligible Applicants

- Cooperatives
- Nonprofit Organizations
- Public-Private Partnerships
- Private Companies
- Public or Private Utilities
- Public Utility Districts
- Local Governments

Eligible Areas

Eligible Areas are determined by the OSIT

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and MDUs
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible MDU
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including registered apprenticeships, preapprenticeships, community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Determination of Priority Broadband Project vs Non-Priority Broadband Project

- Primary Scoring: Applications within the same project area, the application with the lowest grant request will be selected
- **Secondary Scoring**: Applicants within 15% of the lowest grant request for the same application area, the following scoring will be applied

Speed to Deployment (Up to 5 points):

o Project complete in 36 months

Speed of Network (Up to 85 points):

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\circ 85 points – ≥ 10 Gbps ≥ 10 Gbps
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 \circ 75 points - ≥ 5 Gbps and < 10 Gbps ≥ 5 Gbps and < 10 Gbps

 \circ 50 points - ≥ 1 Gbps and < 5 Gbps ≥ 1 Gbps and < 5 Gbps

 \circ 25 points - ≥ 100 Mbps and < 1 Gbps ≥ 100 Mbps and < 1 Gbps

15 points - ≥ 100 Mbps ≥50 Mbps and < 100 Mbps

o points - ≥ 100 Mbps < 50 Mbps

Preliminary Provisional Awardees (Up to 10 points):

10 points for projects that received preliminary award in the previous round
