### Program Details

**Program Name:** Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program (BEAD)

**Administrator:** Nevada Governor's Office of Science, Innovation and Technology (OSIT)

**Match Requirement:** 25% Match required

### Key Dates

- **July 8, 2025** – Benefit of the Bargain Round Application cycle opens
- **July 17, 2025** – Benefit of the Bargain Round Application cycle closes at 5:00 p.m. PDT

### Eligible Projects

- Projects deploying qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved 25/3 Mbps or less and underserved between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps locations

### Eligible Applicants

- Cooperatives
- Nonprofit Organizations
- Public-Private Partnerships
- Private Companies
- Public or Private Utilities
- Public Utility Districts
- Local Governments

### Eligible Areas

- Eligible Areas are determined by the OSIT

## Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and MDUs
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible MDU
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including registered apprenticeships, pre-apprenticeships, community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

## Selection Criteria

### Determination of Priority Broadband Project vs Non-Priority Broadband Project

- **Primary Scoring:** Applications within the same project area, the application with the lowest grant request will be selected
- **Secondary Scoring:** Applicants within 15% of the lowest grant request for the same application area, the following scoring will be applied

#### Speed to Deployment (Up to 5 points):

- Project complete in 36 months

#### Speed of Network (Up to 85 points):

- **85 points** –  $\geq 10 \text{ Gbps}$
- **75 points** -  $\geq 5 \text{ Gbps}$  and  $< 10 \text{ Gbps}$
- **50 points** -  $\geq 1 \text{ Gbps}$  and  $< 5 \text{ Gbps}$
- **25 points** -  $\geq 100 \text{ Mbps}$  and  $< 1 \text{ Gbps}$
- **15 points** -  $\geq 100 \text{ Mbps}$  and  $< 100 \text{ Mbps}$
- **0 points** -  $< 100 \text{ Mbps}$

#### Preliminary Provisional Awardees (Up to 10 points):

- **10 points** for projects that received preliminary award in the previous round
