• Qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved 25/3 Mbps or less and underserved between 25/3 Mbps and 100/20 Mbps locations

Eligible Areas

Project areas determined by the broadband office

Selection Criteria

Determination of Priority Broadband Project vs Non-Priority Broadband Project

• Primary Scoring Criteria

The combination of project proposals with the lowest overall cost to the Program will be selected,. this may involve selecting a proposal that is not the lowest-cost option for a given set of BSLs but is part of the combination of selected projects with the lowest overall cost to the Program

• Secondary Criteria (100 points)

Applicants within 15% of the lowest grant request for the same application area, the following scoring will be applied:

• Speed to Deployment (up to 10 points):

- **10 points** for Speed to Deployment (Project complete within 36 months of award)
- Speed of Network (up to 10 points):
 - o 90 points for 2G/2G
 - 75 points for 1G/1G
 - 50 points for 500Mbps/500Mbps
 - 25 points for 100Mbps/100Mbps
 - 15 points for 100Mbps/50Mbps
 - **0 points** for 100Mbps/20Mbps

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and multi tenant buildings
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible multi-family residential building
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including Registered Apprenticeships and pre-apprenticeships, and community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations
