Match Requirement: 25% Match required

- August 1, 2025 BEAD Round Two closes
- August 31, 2025 Application review, scoring, negotiations, public comment period
- September 4, 2025 Final proposal due to NTIA

Eligible Projects

 Qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved 25/3 Mbps or less and underserved between 25/3 Mbps and 100/20 Mbps locations

Eligible Applicants

- Cooperatives
- Nonprofit Organizations
- Public-Private Partnerships
- Private Companies
- Public or Private Utilities
- Public Utility Districts
- Local Governments

Eligible Areas

Each county will be designated as a separate application area

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and multi tenant buildings
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible multi-family residential building
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including Registered Apprenticeships and pre-apprenticeships, and community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Determination of Priority Broadband Project vs Non-Priority Broadband Project

- Primary Scoring: Applications within the same project area, the application with the lowest grant request will be selected
- **Secondary Scoring**: Applicants within 15% of the lowest grant request for the same application area, the following scoring will be applied
 - 10 points Speed to Deployment
 - 25 points Download Speed

Application Process

 There is no prequalification phase. Aplicants may either submit an updated application in Round Two, resubmit a BEAD Round One application, or withdraw their application.
