Funding Details

Award:

- Minimum: \$200,000
- Maximum: \$5,000,000
- Limited to the lesser of 50% of replacement cost or \$5,000 per pole

Match Requirement: No

Key Dates

August 9, 2024 – Deadline to submit questions to BDO (2:00 pm CT) September 3, 2024 – Application Window Opens September 10 – Application Window Closes

November 1, 2024 – Anticipated issuance of notice of awards

Eligible Applicants

 Pole owners or ISPs who have paid or incurred costs of removing an existing pole in an eligible area to accommodate an Eligible Broadband Facility

Eligible Areas

- Poles must be located in an unserved area
- Applications are limited to poles located in a single county

Eligible Projects

 Only poles applicants can demonstrate have been replaced to accommodate an Eligible Broadband Facility

Eligible Costs

- Costs paid or incurred between Aug 31, 2021 and July 29, 2024 for the following:
 - Removal and disposal of existing pole
 - Purchase and installation of a replacement pole
 - Transfer of any existing facilities to the new pole

Selection Criteria

Scoring (maximum of 150 points):

- Rurality (based on county population) up to 100 points
 - o <50,000: 100 pts</p>
 - 50,001 100,000: 98 pts
 - 100,001 150,000: 96 pts
 - 150,001 200,000: 94 pts
 - 200,001 250,000: 92 pts
 - 250,001 300,000: 90 pts
 - o 300,001+: 0 pts
- Minimal Per Pole Outlay up to 50 points
 - Calculated as discount (below maximum possible per pole) X 100
 - Example: if \$5,000 per pole is available, but applicant only requests \$2,500 (50% discount), applicant will receive the maximum 50 points
