- Must provide a Community Center within the PFSA with a minimum of 2, and up to 10, computer access points and wireless access at 100/20 Mbps, free of charge, to all users for at least 2 years

- Construction, acquisition, or leasing of facilities, spectrum, land, or buildings used to deploy broadband service
- Cost of providing broadband service free of charge to the critical community facilities for 2 years •
- Less than 10% of the grant amount or up to \$150,000 may be used for the improvement, • expansion, construction or acquisition of a community center that provides online access to the public
- Matching funds can be used for operating costs
