- Nonprofit Organizations
- Local Governments
- Tribal Governments
- Internet Service Providers

## **Allowable Challenges**

- Service availability
- Speed
- Latency
- Data cap
- Technology
- Business service only
- Enforceable Commitments
- Planned Service (deployed by June 30, 2024)
- Speed tests will be collected from individuals to be submitted by an eligible challenger in order to determine eligibility

- Complete <u>Challenge Process Survey</u>
- Request a free CostQuest License
- The two license tiers available for the BEAD Challenge Process are:
  - Tier D: For entities that participate in any federal broadband programs. Licensees will be similar to those with an FCC Fabric Tier 2 license. Please follow the guide for requesting a TIER D License
  - Tier E: For entities that will challenge "Pass Through Entity" coverage maps (i.e. the CBO). Licensees will be similar to those with an FCC Fabric Tier 4 license.
    Please follow the guide for requesting a TIER E License
