# **Funding Details**

Award: Projects are eligible for 30% grant and 70% loan funding, until funds are exhausted

- Up to \$5,000,000 for "distressed areas" and in areas identified as "Indian country"
- Up to \$2,000,000 for non-distressed project areas

#### Match Requirement:

- 10% for distressed areas
- 50% for non-distressed areas

# **Eligible Applicants cont.**

- Multi-party Entities
- Limited Liability Corporations (LLC)
- Incorporated Businesses or Partnerships
- Applicant must notify projects area ISPs at least six weeks prior to submission

### **Eligible Areas**

Any area with **unserved** households or businesses (lack access to broadband service above 25/3)

# **Eligible Projects**

Acquisition, installation, and construction of Middle Mile and Last Mile infrastructure that supports deploying broadband service in **unserved areas** 

# **Eligible Costs**

- Construction Labor
- Permitting/Design/Architecture/Engineering/Landscaping
- Construction Management
- Capitalized Equipment
- Real Property when purchased for project

# **Selection Criteria**

#### Scoring (maximum of 100 points):

- Needs, Goals & Impact up to 30 points
- Outreach, Engagement, Equity up to 25 points
- Feasibility, Readiness up to 45 points
