Eligible Applicants

 Internet service providers that have partnered with a community that applied to the GigReady program announced in 2021

Eligible Areas

• **Targeted addresses** – no current access to at least 25/3 Mbps

Eligible Projects

- Applicants may submit multiple proposals containing no more than 5,000 targeted addresses
- Projects must meet a minimum of 100/20 Mbps upon completion and are encouraged to provide at least 1000/500 Mbps
- The grant amount requested should not be greater than \$20 million

Selection Criteria

- Technical/Operational Evaluation up to 100 points
- Financial Evaluation up to 100 points
- Broadband Development Impact Evaluation up to 100 points
