Eligible Projects

 Projects deploying qualifying last-mile broadband infrastructure to unserved (25/3 Mbps or less) and underserved (between 25/3 and 100/20 Mbps) locations

Eligible Costs

- Construction, improvement, and/or acquisition of facilities and telecommunications equipment, including infrastructure for backhaul, middle and last-mile networks, and multi tenant buildings
- Long-term leases of facilities to provide qualifying broadband service, including IRUs
- Deployment of internet and Wi-Fi within an eligible multi-family residential building
- Network software upgrades
- Engineering design, permitting, and work related to environmental, historical, and cultural reviews
- Personnel costs, including salaries and fringe benefits for staff and consultants
- Training for cybersecurity professionals working on BEAD-funded networks
- Workforce development including Registered Apprenticeships and pre-apprenticeships, and community college and/or vocational training for broadband-related occupations

Selection Criteria

Scoring (maximum of 100 points): Primary criteria

- Minimal BEAD Outlay (up to 40 points): Based on BEAD match threshold, cost model, and network quality.
- **Priority Affordability (up to 18 points):** Based on total non-promo cost of 1 GB / 1 GB.
- Fair Labor Practices (up to 17 points):
 - Based on prior compliance record for entities in operation

Secondary criteria

- **Speed to Deployment (up to 1 point):** Awarded for enforceable deployments faster than 36 months
- Local and Tribal Engagement (up to 5 points): Points for demonstrated community support and local/tribal coordination
- **Government and Tribal Endorsements (up to 7 points):** Awarded for formal endorsements from County and/or Tribal government
- Affordability Middle Class and Low-Cost Plan (up to 10 points): Based on cost of service to the customer and reach of req'd low-cost plan
- **Community Anchor Institutions (up to 2 points):** Based on inclusion of CAIs without a symmetrical gig of service
