- October 25 Commission releases determinations on credibility of partial challenges
- December 6 Grant Awards Released

# **Eligible Applicants**

- Internet service providers (ISP) including any telecommunications company, cable television company, or wireless network provider
- Cooperatives
- Political subdivisions, as part of a public-private partnership with ISP
- Indian tribes, as part of a public-private partnership with ISP

# **Eligible Areas**

- Unserved Area locations lack access to internet service at speeds of at least 25/3Mbps
- Underserved Area locations lack access to internet service at speeds of at least 100/20Mbps
  - Applications in underserved areas must include a digital inclusion plan
  - Plan must describe carrier's efforts to ensure affordability of the services offered, and must describe discounts and/ or support programs
- High-cost Project Area the Commission will publish a spreadsheet of high cost Nebraska census blocks

# Eligible Projects

- Broadband network projects in an unserved area or an underserved area
- Maximum grant amount is \$5 million for a single project

# **Evaluation Criteria**

- Applications will first be sorted into prioritization tiers
  - Priority Tier 1 unserved area lacking 25/3 Mbps and has not received prior funding
  - Priority Tier 2 unserved area lacking 25/3 Mbps and has received federal broadband funding but construction will
    not be completed within 24 months of the NBBP grant application deadline
  - Priority Tier 3 underserved area lacking 100/20 Mbps with a digital inclusion plan
- Application Scoring/Weighting Criteria (155 points max)
  - Financial Capability Demonstrated (up to 10 points)
  - Legal Capability Demonstrated (up to 10 points)
  - Technical Capability (up to 15 points)
  - Rate Comparability (up to 10 points)
  - Speed Additive (up to 10 points)
  - Match Score (up to 10 points)
  - Match Percentage (up to 55 points)
  - Digital Inclusion Plans (up to 5 points)
  - ETC Certification (up to 5 points)
  - Location Density (up to 20 points)
  - Public Partnership (up to 5 points)

# **Middle Mile**

Middle mile is an allowable cost



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# **Eligible Costs**

- NBBP pays up to 50% of the eligible development costs (amount paid for acquisition and deployment of infrastructure scalable to at least 100/100Mbps) for a qualifying project if located outside a high-cost area
  - 75% of the eligible development costs of the project if located inside a high-cost area
- Allowed Costs
  - Project planning, engineering costs, obtaining construction permits, construction of facilities including both middlemile and last-mile infrastructure, equipment, regulatory and compliance, direct labor and contract labor, and installation and testing of the broadband Internet service
- Disallowed Costs
  - Legal expenses, lease initiation costs, interest/financing expenses, ongoing operating costs, contractor milestone
    payments, liability costs, repair of lawns/sidewalks, system maintenance agreements, labor not directly related to the
    project, collocation fees, taxes, refundable costs (deposits)
